



SWDCS 2018-2019 Uniform Policy

SHIRTS

Polo shirts should be **navy blue** for students in **Kindergarten through 5th Grade** . Polo shirts should be **light blue** for students in **6th through 8th Grade** . Either long or short sleeve shirts are acceptable. Shirts with the school logo are available for purchase.

SWEATERS

Students may wear either dark blue or black sweaters with buttons or zippers. Sweater should not have hoods, writing, or printing on them. **ONLY** hoodies with the SWDCS logo are allowed but the hoods are never to be on student's head while in school.

PANTS/SKIRTS/JUMPERS

Bottoms must be black, navy blue or khaki. Skirts and jumpers must be knee length or longer with no other colors or markings on them. Jeans, jeggings or leggings are not permitted.

SHOES AND SOCKS

Socks or tights can be white, dark blue or black. Shoes should be mostly black or brown. If snow boots need to be worn the student must have appropriate school shoes to change into upon entering the building.

OTHER DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

Students are permitted to bring backpacks for their school supplies. Backpacks are kept in the classroom or the student's designated locker/storage area. Students will have access to their backpack at the teacher's discretion.

Hats, scarves, bandanas, and head coverings may not be worn in the school building, unless for religious or medical reasons and with prior approval of the principal. Any other decorative hair accessories that the Principal deems to be distracting may not be worn at school. Athletic caps, visors, athletic-style headbands, and sunglasses may not be worn inside the school.

For safety reasons, jewelry should be simple. No student may wear earrings in any other visible body part (e.g., nose rings, eyebrow rings, etc.). Necklaces may be worn under a shirt only. Bangle or multiple bracelets, hoop earrings or dangling earrings are not allowed.

Any clothing or grooming (including hair, make-up, or nail polish) that, in the principal's judgment, may reasonably be expected to cause disruption or interfere with normal school operations will not be allowed.
